# Hart County School District Non-Traditional School Day Informational Sheet

# What is a Non-Traditional School Plan? Raider Day

The Hart County School District has been awarded a waiver so that instruction will be delivered for all students during a day when school is closed due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., snow days). Each of these days will be identified as a Raider Day.

#### **Delivery:**

Both online and hard copy content will be available for students on Non-Traditional School Days.

Students will know prior to a Raider Day the work they are expected to complete.

#### Preparation:

Teachers are providing accessible assignments through Google Classroom, various online programs, or instructional packets (paper/pencil).

#### When:

The district utilizes the In Touch System and the local news media to announce school closings. When a Raider Day and a corresponding number is announced, students will know the assignments that are expected to be completed on that day.

#### Content:

Instructions for accessing the online content will be provided to students. Instructional packet folders will be sent home with students in early December. Students without online access will not be penalized.



### Accountability:

Students will be required and should make every effort to complete all tasks assigned during a Raider Day; however, students will have three (3) school days to complete their work for those instances whereby the work could not be completed due to extenuating circumstances (i.e., loss of power or no Wi-Fi).

#### Staff:

ALL staff, certified and classified, will have job responsibilities on Raider Days. The school closing announcement will indicate if the staff is to work from home or report to their schools. Details of these responsibilities will be provided from the immediate supervisor.

#### Availability:

Teachers are required to maintain on-line presence during particular time spans established by each school. Detailed schedules will be posted online and will be sent home with students prior to the first Raider Day. Parents or students may also call the school and leave a message with the principal.
